WOODLOCH SUMMER HORSE CAMP 2017

Sign up NOW to enjoy one or more sessions of Woodloch's Summer Horse Camps! Sessions are open for riders ages 7 through 18, of every level and ability. Throughout the 40 years of Woodloch's existence, we have been able to put together a comprehensive learning experience for the students which include first and foremost safety for horse and rider, horse care, tacking properly on and off the horse, riding and learning about the walk, trot and the canter. Learn how the horse learns! Each student is responsible for a horse throughout the week with structured lessons, discussions, demonstrations and supervised practice rides. Trail rides and a cookout are among other activities in this educational and fun camp.

Summer 2017 we will offer:

1. Advanced western horsemanship camps July 10th – 14th or August 7th-11th: Student must have attended previous day camps or have been in lessons for at least one year, be 11 years old or older, with the skills required to be confident in walk, trot, and canter. Students will be screened for safety reasons. These weeks include many fun trail patterns, horsemanship and games; this is a camp for students with competitive aspirations only and are in a weekly lesson program. Students work with more advanced horses, and will learn about training the young horse. Demo riders/ instructors will teach and demonstrate their skills to us. THIS IS NOT OVERNIGHT CAMP.

2. 2 and 3 day camp; are geared toward the very beginner 7 —10 year; old

Age-appropriate activities, safety, skills and confidence-building around and on horses is the main focus.

- **3. All other day camp weeks** this summer will be geared toward the regular beginner student ages 9-18, learning basic age appropriate skill and confidence building, to learn about good horsemanship, horse care and have structured riding every day.
- 4. T-shirts are available to campers for an additional \$20.00, pre-paid at the time of registration along with the non-refundable \$150.00 deposit. Please be aware that we are Tie-Dyeing our t-shirts this year, so if you would like your child to receive a shirt, it MU\$T be ordered with your registration BEFORE camp.

Reserve your spot early, as class size is limited to ensure individualized attention. Every effort is made to group students of like abilities and ages. Day camps are not geared towards students with special needs; please inquire regarding special needs opportunities.

We request that campers wear long pants and a hard-soled shoe or boot with a heel. Approved Equestrian Helmets are required as of Jan 1st, 2015 for all Woodloch riders due to insurance. We do sell them at our lesson office; please inquire. You can also buy helmets at Fleet Farm and St. Croix Saddlery in Hugo. Please dress for the weather and bring a bag lunch and a drink daily (a refrigerator is available).

To register, send in the registration form with your \$150.00 non-refundable deposit, plus t-shirt fee if desired. The balance is due on the first day of camp by check or cash only.

Your deposit will confirm your reservation and a confirmation letter will be emailed to you prior to your scheduled camp.
